

**Dr. Brian O'Leary statement / press conference Barcelona, July 24, 2009**

My name is Brian O'Leary. After I received my Ph.D. from the University at Berkeley in 1967, I worked for NASA as a scientist-astronaut, the first appointed for a Mars mission.

However, the program was cancelled, and so I left NASA to teach at several universities.

I taught astronomy at Cornell University with Carl Sagan, the legendary astronomer, and worked in various NASA planetary missions in the late 60s and 70s.

In 1975, I was a special staff consultant on Energy for the US House Interior subcommittee on energy and the environment in the US House of Representatives.

As a scientist, I had always thought that each and every phenomenon can be properly explained by mainstream science, or will be in the future.

But in 1979, when I was working for the physics department of Princeton University, I had a spontaneous remote-viewing experience, and shortly after that, I had a near-death experience and a healing experience.

Those experiences profoundly altered my perspective, and I wrote several books about such phenomena.

Most importantly, I discovered that many things that lie outside the box of mainstream science are nevertheless susceptible to scientific inquiry using scientific methods.

This was to lead to a three decades of intensive research on new science topics such as UFO/ET and paranormal phenomena and new energy research.

Many mainstream scientists still avoid to deal with the UFO/ET issue, for fear of ridicule, or because the phenomena observed won't fit the existing paradigm of what we call reality.

However, science itself clearly demonstrates the reality of the UFO phenomenon. In fact, the evidence for advanced craft visiting Earth and ET contacts is quite overwhelming. All you have to do is to look without prejudice at the facts.

There is also convincing evidence that the extraterrestrial presence has not only been ridiculed – it has been covered up by governments, military and intelligence agencies for over 60 years now.

Why would they deny such a great discovery?

In 1961, NASA commissioned the so-called “Brookings-Report, Proposed Studies on the Implications of Peaceful Space Activities for Human Affairs”, which was submitted to the US House of Representatives.

It suggests that contact with extraterrestrial civilizations, or strong evidence of their reality, could have a disruptive effect on humanity.

It therefore mentions the possibility of withholding such evidence from the public.

It's true that the discovery of ET civilizations visiting Earth would profoundly change the way our societies work.

The more so if you think about our dependency on fossil fuels. Whatever propulsion systems these advanced space craft might use – it's perfectly clear they won't operate on fossil fuels, which our current world economy and power structures rely on.

The possible introduction of new clean energy technologies might well be one of the strongest reasons for the cover-up.

I have spent many years travelling and visiting laboratories around the world of researchers of new energy technologies.

I have personally seen devices which generate a large surplus of energy but require our support to develop useful devices.

These technologies are revolutionary, they tap into the so-called zero-point-energy field or use catalysts to initiate energetic nonradioactive nuclear reactions and special chemical reactions involving water or hydrogen.

There are many clean and cheap energy technologies out there already – but the unfortunate message is, these technologies are also being suppressed, and their inventors often threatened and even assassinated.

I will further elaborate on the political, social and economic potential of a free energy economy during my talk.

We have the enormous potential to create an abundant, future for humanity and a sustainable future for our deteriorating environment if we can pursue clean `free` energy technologies under responsible stewardship.

But this requires an entirely new leadership, not based on fear and greed but on a sense of compassion for all of life on our imperiled planet.

We are not alone in the universe, and we could learn a lot of things from these highly-advanced beings.

Do we want to continue the way we've been doing things so far? Or do we want to create a sustainable future, with peace and clean energy technologies?

It's time for mankind to wake up and to take its proper role in the universe.

That's what I'm here for, to support the international exopolitics movement in bringing forward the truth about the ET presence and suppressed energy technologies.

Because what's at stake is nothing less than the future of ourselves. Of mankind. Of all of nature.
